HOW TO ENTER? NOMINATION FORM

- In the interest of fairness and consistency, the application template is the only means of Apprentice nomination. This ensures that the nominee's attributes are clearly outlined in a standardised and 'across the board' format. Nominations are ideally intended for final-year apprentices and trainees nearing the end of their course, however if you feel that you have a third-year apprentice who 'shines above all others' then please nominate him or her. In the interests of confidentiality, this Nomination Form allows separate input from the Employer and the Registered Training Organisation.

WHAT IS NEEDED? FORM INFORMATION

- **The Employer section of the Nomination Form is designed to provide input on:**

- ✓ The quality level of practical work skills & the application of those skills in the workplace
- ✓ Safe working practices
- ✓ Customer interaction
- ✓ General attitudes & behaviour.

The RTO Section Asks For Comment On:

- ✓ Involvement and cooperation in classroom activities
- ✓ Diligence with all training tasks such as work books & projects
- ✓ Mention of results from oral and written assessments of theoretical knowledge, and
- ✓ Comment on any practical simulation carried out.



WHAT'S NEXT? ADJUDICATION

- The MAOTY Adjudicator will initially assess submissions. The Adjudicator will make phone contact with each of the nominees for a detailed technical discussion as a means of verifying the individuals underpinning knowledge within the trade. All inputs are collated to determine the final assessment outcome. The Adjudicator then submits a report and recommendations to the National Committee for review and confirmation.
